What we offer:

Basic - Hygiene supplies, menstrual hygiene, lice treatment, snacks, food bags, hot meal & pantry information, animal food and care, free bin, socks

Case Management - Appointment accompaniment, public benefits application help, support in Emotional Support Animal registration, ID & Birth Certificate applications, community resource referrals, legal support, one-on-one counseling

Harm Reduction - Needle exchange, vein care, safer injection supplies, overdose prevention training, Narcan prescriptions, support for detox and substance use treatment entry

Mental Health - Harm Reduction therapy, mental health support and medication

Medical - Volunteer medical staff at SFNE

We are an access point for Coordinated Entry for Youth

HYA staff are here to speak with you one-on-one or get coffee, tea or a meal. We offer compassionate, nonjudgemental support and info that will help you meet your goals such as get documents, navigate housing or receiving healthcare.
